

Component identification



- Actual appearance may differ from the illustration.
- The crown has two positions when pulling it out.

Setting the time

- 1. Pull the crown out to position 2 when the second hand points 0 second.**
The second hand stops.
- 2. Rotate the crown to set the time.**
 - Move the hands 4 or 5 minutes forward and move them back to the right time to set the time more precisely.
- 3. Push the crown in to position 0 in accordance with a reliable time source.**
The second hand starts moving.

Setting the moon phase indication

- 1. Pull the crown out to position 1.**
- 2. Rotate the crown clockwise to set the moon phase.**
 - Refer to a newspaper or other source to see actual moon phase.
 - Use the indicated moon phase only as a reference.
 - Appearance of the indication may differ in some models.
 - The moon phase can be set more accurately when it is new or full moon.
